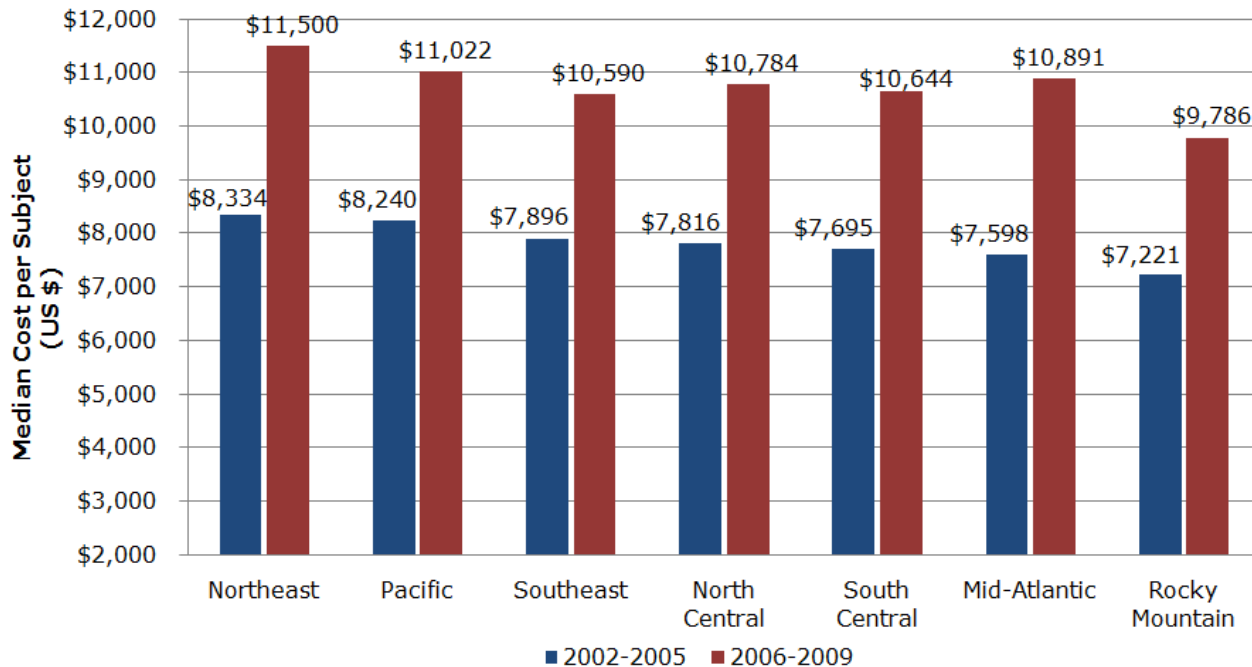


## Spotlight on Research Fees: Site Fees by Region in the United States

The median site fee per subject for Phase I-IV clinical trials in all therapeutic areas increased by 37% from 2002-2005 to 2006-2009. In both time periods, the Rocky Mountain region had the lowest median fee per subject, the gap with the Northeast increasing from 15% to 18% over the two time periods. Mid-Atlantic fees increased the most (43%), while the highest cost regions, Northeast and Pacific, increased the least (34%).
