

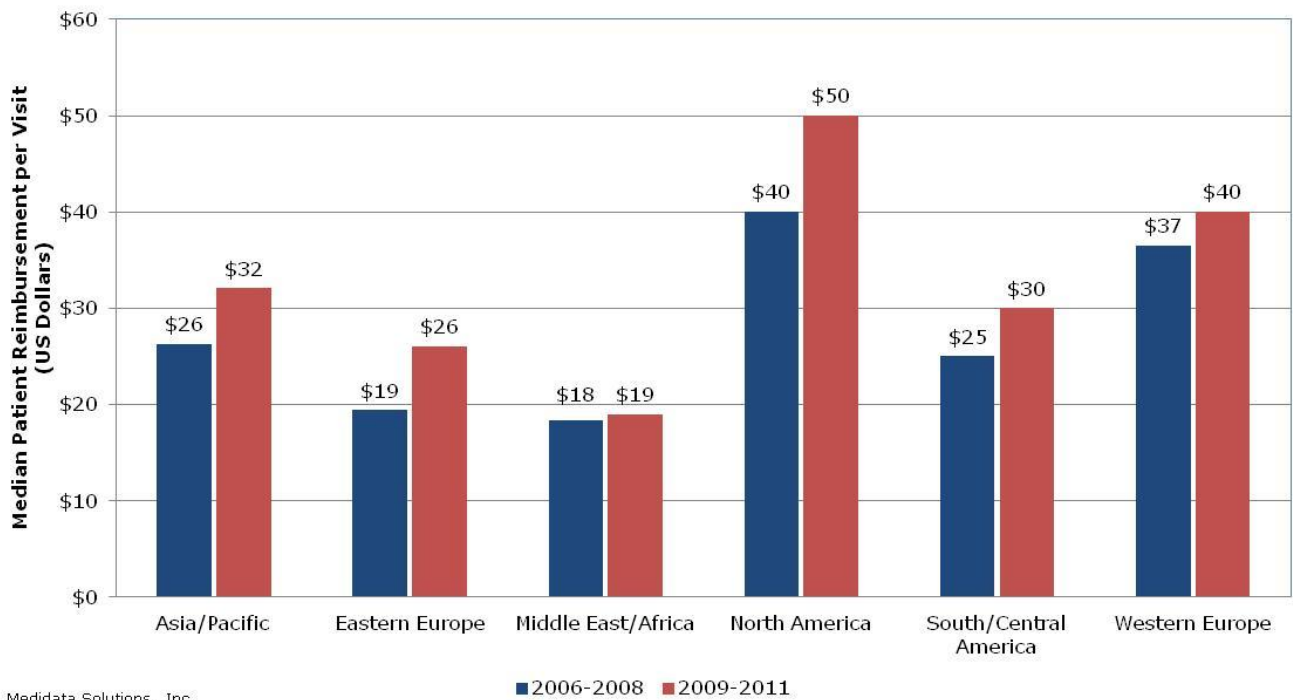
Spotlight on Research Fees: Subject Stipend/Reimbursement per Visit

The median subject stipend/reimbursement per visit has increased across every region from 2006-2008 to 2009-2011. The most significant increase was in Eastern Europe: 34%. America and Asia/Pacific experienced moderate increases, 24% and 22%, respectively. The smallest increase was in Middle East/Africa: 4%. North America and Western Europe continue to have the largest stipends/reimbursements, \$50 and \$40, respectively. Middle East/Africa continues to have the smallest: \$19.
